**Hurstmere Banding Assessments (Non-Verbal Reasoning)**

**Monday 2<sup>nd</sup>, Tuesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> and Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2024**

**Assessments will be held from 4pm – 6pm on each of the 3 days**

In accordance with the Coordinated School Admission Arrangements parents will be sent a letter saying which school their child has been offered. This letter will be posted by first class post on the first working day of March.

**Appeals for Secondary Transfer 2025**

Parents have the right to appeal this decision. They may do so by writing to the Governors at the school address, within 20 days of hearing that their child has not been allocated a place at Hurstmere. The school will then forward the necessary Appeal documentation, which must be completed and returned to Hurstmere within 20 days of receipt.

The dates *provisionally* scheduled for Hurstmere appeals are between April – June.

Parents are asked to ensure that all details are correctly entered on the Common Application Form. Hurstmere reserves the right to withdraw any place offered on the basis of incorrect information. Such withdrawal may be made subsequent to a pupil's entry to Hurstmere.
